

Radiation level map of Koriyama City (October, 2015)

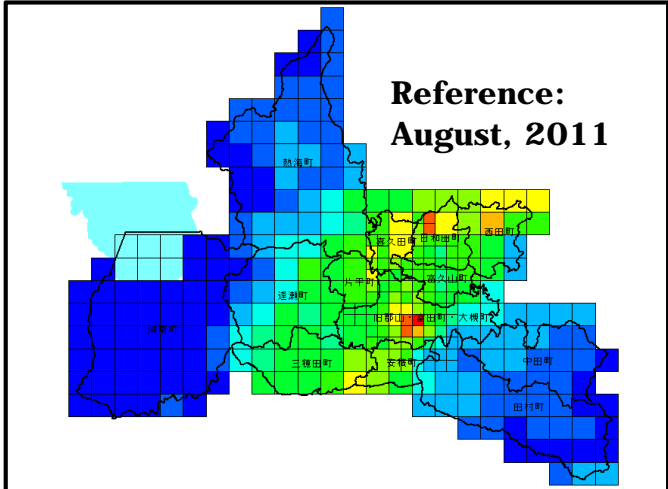
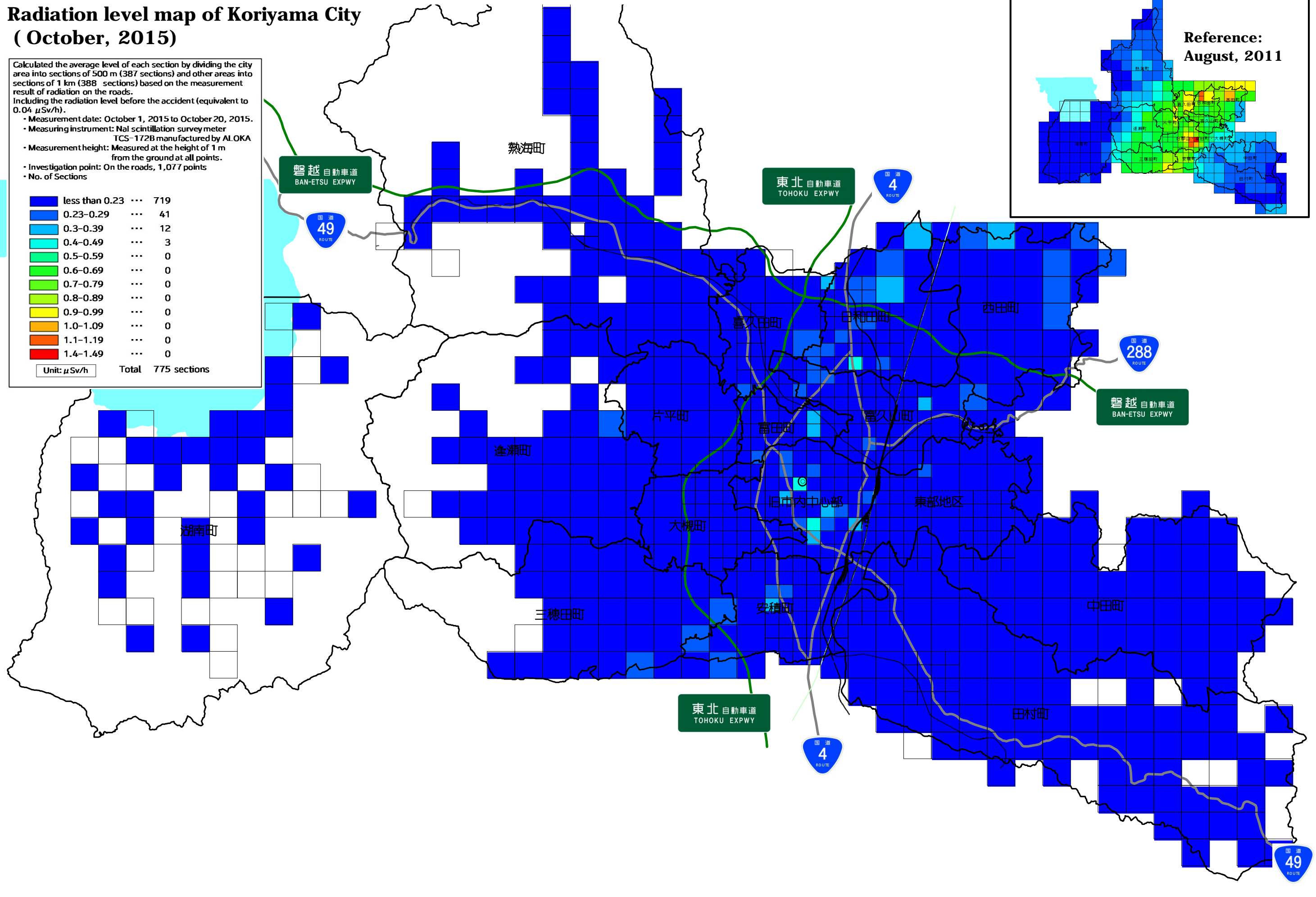
Calculated the average level of each section by dividing the city area into sections of 500 m (387 sections) and other areas into sections of 1 km (388 sections) based on the measurement result of radiation on the roads.

Including the radiation level before the accident (equivalent to 0.04 $\mu\text{Sv/h}$).

- Measurement date: October 1, 2015 to October 20, 2015.
- Measuring instrument: NaI scintillation survey meter TCS-172B manufactured by ALOKA
- Measurement height: Measured at the height of 1 m from the ground at all points.
- Investigation point: On the roads, 1,077 points
