

The COVID-19 vaccination program in Koriyama is in full progress. All residents of Koriyama City have been sent vaccination coupons by mail.



The envelope includes the vaccine coupon, with a coupon number. Use this number to make your reservation.

Also, a Pre-Vaccination Questionnaire is included. Please fill it in before going to the vaccination clinic. A translation of the questionnaire can be found on the



website below, but be sure to fill in the original Japanese questionnaire.

Once you have received your coupon,

you can make a reservation at either a Collective Vaccination Venue, or your local clinic.
