## Museum of Art: "Ukiyoe that Challenges Kuniyoshi, Yoshitoshi... and More!" Exhibit

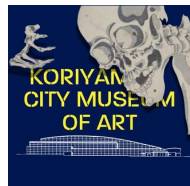
Until the **6<sup>th</sup> of June**, the Koriyama City Museum of Art present an exhibition on 19<sup>th</sup> century ukiyo-e paintings. **Utagawa Kuniyoshi** (1797-1861) is known for creating dynamic ukiyo-e during the late Edo to early Meiji periods (latter-half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century). His apprentice **Yoshitoshi Tsukioka** (1839-1892) is considered the last great ukiyo-e master. The exhibition features about 150 rich, expressive works from a group of artists whose period of time provided them with a lively curiosity and new ways of thinking.

**Date:** 24<sup>th</sup> of April – 6<sup>th</sup> of June, 2021

**Opening hours:** 9:30 - 17:00 (admission until 16:30)

**Closed:** Mondays (except 3 May) and 6 May, 2021

**Price:** (Adults) ¥800, (University-/High School Students and 65+) ¥500, (Elementary and Junior High School Students) Free.

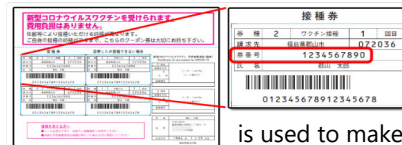

## COVID-19 Vaccination Program (Update)

The COVID-19 vaccination program in Koriyama has started for citizens 65 years of age and older. Depending on the supply of vaccines, **Vaccination Tickets** will be sent by mail. Tickets will be sent out in the following order: (1) citizens 65+ years of age, (2) people with underlying medical conditions, (3) people working at elderly care facilities, (4) all other citizens.



The envelope will include this vaccine ticket, with a ticket number. This number

is used to make your reservation.

A Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire will also be included. Please fill in the questionnaire before going to the vaccination venue or clinic. A translation of the questionnaire can be found on the website below, but please **fill in the original Japanese questionnaire**.

Once you have received your ticket, you can make a reservation at either a Collective Vaccination Venue, or your local clinic. For details, Koriyama City has a page with information on the roll-out of the COVID-19 vaccine in English and Easy Japanese. It includes information on making reservations, consultation services and more.
