

Fukkou No Tomoshibi Project

Coming March 11th marks the 10th anniversary of the Great East Japan Earthquake. As a covid-proof means of memorializing this tragic day, Koriyama City is organizing the **Fukkou no Tomoshibi** (Lights of Revitalization) Project. Lanterns made of Ebine-Washi traditional Japanese paper will be set up at Station's West-Exit Square, to commemorate the victims. The lanterns were made by the Ebine-Washi Preservation Association, in collaboration with the Koriyama Women's College. They will include the special





lanterns made and painted by the members of popular pop-group and Frontier Ambassadors for Koriyama, GReeeeN. The event will also feature paper-making workshops, the sale of emergency-goods, and the screening of a video introducing the craft of Ebine-Washi. When attending the event, please take COVID-precautions, such as wearing a mask, practicing social distancing and coughing etiquette.

The Fukkou no Tomoshibi Project webpage also features a 'Fukkou Tree', where you can add your own message, memories of the disaster, and wishes for the future to the tree's leaves. Although we may not be able gather this year, let's join together in commemoration.

Confidentiality is guaranteed. The line is free, available 24/7, and accommodates 19 languages (see below) using an on-thephone interpreter. TEL: 0120-992-860

You can even contact the service using the popular messenger арр LINE. Add @fukushimacovidcall, and use the phone icon to give them a call. You will be directed to an interpreting service.

Legal Consultation for Foreign Residents

Legal consultation on daily life will be available over the phone with an administrative scrivener, organized by the Fukushima International Exchange Association (FIA). Confidentiality is guaranteed.

Consultation time: Up to 30 minutes per person Participants: Foreign residents in Fukushima Prefecture **Number of participants:** 10 people (first-come, first-serve) **Consultation fee:** Free (phone charges do apply)

Application period: February 2nd - 24th. After completing the application, the consultation date/time will be decided. How to apply: The application form can be downloaded on

website (www.worldvillage.org/life/ news.html?id=3883) or requested directly. After filling in the form, please send it to FIA by e-mail, mail or by bringing it to FIA's office.
