Starting the 1st of December, the Koriyama Skating Rink in Bandai-Atami will officially be open to the public, and the season is kicked off with this annual event. The main event is the Tsururinko tug-of-war-on-ice. Teams of five will face off on the slippery ice floor for the grand prize of 100.000 yen! Servings of the famous Tsururinko Nabe (hotpot) will be handed out for free (but be ready to queue for a while) and you are free to skate on the 400-meter track (except for the part partitioned off for the tug-of-war). Typhoon Hagibis

From the 12th until the morning of the 13th of October, Typhoon Hagibis passed over Japan. It brought an unprecedented amount of rain, with a total of 284.5mm. This led to a rapid rise in the water levels of the Abukuma river and its tributaries, resulting river floods in several places. The damage is the areas around the rivers was very large and in several places landslides also occurred. Six people in Koriyama City lost their lives, people lost their homes, cars and other properties, and there was considerably damage to roads, schools and other public facilities. Koriyama City will work towards the quick and full recovery from this disaster.

Living in a country that is prone to natural disasters, it is important to be prepared. Knowing where and when to evacuate, and having a emergency kit ready can be literal lifesavers. 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Ebine Nagatsuki Yoi-Akari (Akibotaru)

The annual **Ebine Nagatsuki Yoi-Akari** (also known as **Akibotaru**) event took place on the **14th and 15th of September**. In the Nakatamachi-area on the north-east side of the city, around 600 lanterns made of traditional Ebinewashi paper home to the area were lined up in rows, cre-



ating a unique, calm atmosphere welcoming the coming of fall for the many visitors. This year, the event included lanterns by Koriyama City's very own band 'GReeeeN'.

Visit by Dutch Agricultural Counselor

As a Host Town for the Netherlands, on the **27**th **of September**, Koriyama City welcomed the Agricultural Counselar from the Dutch Embassy in Tokyo for a site visit. Themes for the visit were sustainability, local production/local consumption and nutritional education. After a visit to a local supermarket to learn about their efforts towards sustainability and local produce, the counselor visited Tachibana Elementary School to enjoy a school lunch with the children. In the afternoon, there was time for a visit to a local farm which produces some of Koriyama's designated Brand Vegetables, as well as one of the restaurant that serves them. The counselor expressed that he had an enjoyable and informative visit.

Sasagawa Daizenji Route Officially Opened

Koriyama City just got a little more accessible. The newly opened **Sasagawa Daizenji Route**, running 2.360 m, connects Route 49 with the road to the Koriyama Minami IC on the Tohoku Expressway. The road was officially opened with a ceremony on the **15th of September**, with performances by the taiko group of Teikyo Asaka High School and the choir and brass band of the Nihon University High School. This route, plans for which started being developed all the way back in 1988, is especially important for companies in the industrial parks on the east side of Abukuma River. The new route also features the new-



ly constructed **Sasagawa Bridge** (*Sasagawa Ōhashi*) near Asaka Nagamori Station. It is expected to relieve a great deal of traffic congestion from other routes in the city, as well as make life in Koriyama. Take a drive and explore it for yourself! **MAP:** https://bit.ly/2qu0HZy

Utsukushima Yosakoi Matsuri 2019

YRACS (Yurakkusu) Atama was the stage for the **Utsukushi-ma Yosakoi Matsuri 2019** on **September 15th and 16th**. Over two days, around 60 Yosakoi groups from in- and outside of Fukushima Pref. danced their hearts out, with colorful costumes and original choreographies. The audience was blown away by the powerful performances.



Do You Know Koriyama?

It's hard to miss, being one of the first things you see when you arrive in Koriyama. It's also the biggest building in Koriyama City, and of Fukushima Prefecture at large: the **Big-i**. Completed in March 2001, the building became a landmark of the city with its 24 floors, extending 133 meters into the sky. The planetarium (Koriyama Fureai Science Center - Space Park) on the 20th-24th floors has the honor of being registered in the **Guiness Book of World Records** as the highest planetarium from the ground level. The Space Park's observation deck is open and free of charge, offering the best view over the city and its surrounding area. Big-i is also home to various stores, office spaces, the Citizens' Service Center of Koriyama City Hall and even Koriyama Housei High School! Big-i offers parking spaces for up to 437 vehicles. It's the perfect place to start or end your visit to Koriyama City!
