Koriyama City Music Day Event

On the 6th of September, Koriyama City showed its

colors as a Music City for the **Koriyama City Music Day** event. Organized by the Koriyama City Chamber of Commerce, music events and activities were held throughout the city, the main one being the music stage in front of Koriyama Station. The show was opened by the fantastic choir of the Oshima Elementary School, and featured bands and artists like the city's very own *Gakutokun Band*, *HARUKA*, *Hitoribochi Hidekichi* and virtuoso violinist **Noé Inui** (BE).

Simultaneously, a **free-to-play street piano** was opened at a very unusual location: the Asaka PA rest stop on the Tohoku Expressway, and the public piano at Usui Department Store also featured a special performance. The young and promising enseble of violinists **Cutie Strings** performed at the S-PAL shopping area in Koriyama Station. The day was closed at DJ Bar DOOZ, where the organizers were able to look back at a succesful event.



Bandai-Atami Ice Arena Re-opened

The Bandai-Atami area, on the north-west side of Koriyama City is not only known for having a number of great onsen hot-springs, but also some top-notch sports facilities. One of these is the Bandai-Atami Ice Arena, a full-fledged ice rink, frequented by the Tohoku Freeblades ice-hockey team for their home games several times per year. The Ice Arena is open starting September.* Therefore, on the **1st of September**, despite the heat outside, the Ice Arena was officially re-opened for the upcoming winter season. With only ¥400 the entrance fee is cheap and skates can be rented at the Ice Arena for a reasonable price as well. With the onsen-facility Yurakkusu (YRACS) Atami right

next door, as well as various other onsen in walking-distance, why not have a soak to relax after hitting the rink? For more information, such as availability (the rink may be rented out), be sure to check out the monthly calendar on the ice arena's website (www.icearena.jp) before your visit to avoid dissappoint.

*The outdoor skating rink at the Bandai-Atami Sports Park will re-open starting December.

Do You Know Koriyama?

It is an easy place to pass by without ever noticing it. Nonetheless, it is a place with historical significance: the **crossing of the Oshu-and Aizu Kaido** (routes). Kaido were routes used to connect Edo (then-Tokyo) with various regions. The Oshu Kaido was an important route, as it connected Edo to the Mutsu Province (current Fukushima, Miyagi, lwate and Aomori Prefectures). This part of the Aizu Kaido leads from Koriyama to Aizu-Wakamatsu. During the Edo-period (1600 - 1868), Koriyama was a post town on the Oshu Kaido. The crossing point of these routes was indicated by waystones. The stones for this crossing which can be found near the west-exit of Koriyama Station. They waystones are an important piece of heritage for the city. Next time you have some time to kill at Koriyama Station, why not have a look? **Location: https://bit.ly/324XH3m**
