Asakakunitsuko Festival (Koriyama Fall Festival)

Asakakunitsuko Shrine (near Koriyama Station) is a shrine with a long history. It is said to have been established during the reign of Emperor Seimu, between the years 131 and 191 AD. During the fall season shrines from all over the city pay homage to the shrine. Koriyama's Aki Matsuri (Fall Festival) from September 27th



to the 29th marks the start of this season. The main event is the carrying of the o-mikoshi (portable shrines) of the various different shrines from throughout Koriyama's city center on the third day (September the 29th). Citizens carry the shrines around the station area and make a stop at the Asakakunitsuko Shrine for prayer. The procession is a festive event taking about 2 hours, with the shrines being rocked and spun around in celebration in the city streets, under the cheers of 'wasshoi!' (Heave-ho!) Come to the city center to cheer them on and enjoy the food and drinks from the festival stalls.

Cooperation with the City of Essen (GER)

The City of Essen in Germany and Koriyama City have been further deepening their ties of extensive exchange activities. Start-

ing with the contact between Fukushima Prefecture and the region of North-Rhine Westphalia in Germany with regards to medical equipment development and renewable energy, the city of Essen (which is located in the same region) and Koriyama City were linked in 2018 as partners in the EU's International Urban Cooperation Programme. Since then, delegations from the two cities have been exchanged several times. The last such occasions was the visit of Koriyama City's delegation to Essen in August. On the 2nd of September, a delegation led by the mayor of the city of Essen visited Koriyama City to sign a comprehensive Memorandum of Understanding. The cities have committed themselves to further exchange in the future.

Hydrogen Energy System at Wholesale Market Koriyama City is home to the Fukushima Renewable Energy Institute, AIST (FREA) since 2014. The institute does cutting-edge research for the development and commercialization of new renewable energy technology. One such projects is the development of hydrogen as an alternative fuel source.

In collaboration with Shimizu Construction, and supported by the city government, starting the 23rd of July the Koriyama City General Wholesale Market became the testing ground for a new energy system. The surplus energy generated by the solar panels on the site of the market will be stored in the form of hydrogen, which can then be used to stably provide power to the market's facilities. By introducing this new system, the center aims to reduce its Co²-emission by 40%. It is also a great way for the researchers to see their project in action. City Hall offers a hydrogen refueling station, and owns a hydrogen fuel cell vehicle, with the aim to proactively support the development of hydrogen technology.



Online Document Application

Starting this month it is possible to apply for your jūminhyō (city registration doc-




ument) or inkan-tōroku-shōmeisho (personal seal registration) online, and have it be ready for you when you arrive. This may save you a lot of time. Visit the website listed below, fill in the form and you will receive a confirmation e-mail. Once city hall has confirmed your application, you will receive an e-mail listing when you can pick up your document. As a general rule, if you file your application before 16:00, you will be able to pick it up the next morning. If you fill it in after 16:00, it will be ready after 12:00 the next day (note that you cannot pick up your documents on days when city hall is closed, e.g. weekends/holidays). Do You Know Koriyama?

If you ever took a walk or bike-ride through the area around Kaiseizan Park, you may have wandered onto a little path that goes along a little babbling creek. This little stream actually flows from the Asaka Canal. The 4.4 km long walking path along it is called 'Seseragi-Komichi', and was constructed between 1996 and 2001. It starts near Asaka High School in the Daishin-area, flows along the south-side of Kaiseizan Park, and up north through the Nishi-no-Uchi and Wakabamachi areas all the way to Ouse River. Although the waterway mainly transports domestic wastewater, it is split up in a top- and bottom layer, with the top layer being reserved for clean purified water. The bottom-layer can also be used by firefighters to put out fires. The walking path is adorned with abundant greenery and decoration, making Seseragi-Komichi an important place both for recreation and safety.
