Joe Hisaishi Spring Concert 2019

A legend of film music will perform in Koriyama on the **27**th of April at the Cultural Center: Joe Hisaishi. An incredibly prolific and gifted composer, he is not only well known for some of the most recognizable soundtracks of Ghibli-films from Nausicaa to Ponyo, but also the soundtracks for various other films, such as Kikujiro. As a conductor and pianist, he has toured around the world performing his soundtracks among others. During this Spring Concert, he is joined by the Sendai Philharmonic Orchestra to perform his music from Castle in the Sky, as well as Brahms' 1st Symphony. Be sure to get your tickets early!

3/11 remembrance: 'GReeeeN' Lantern Lighting

This year's **March 11th** marked the 8th anniversary of the Great East Japan disaster of 2011. In commemoration, the city collaborated with the band GReeeeN (recently assigned as Frontier Ambassadors for the city) for a event at Koriyama Station's West Exit Square. Both GReeeeN and the children from the Haga Elementary School wrote messages and their dreams for the revitalization of Koriyama on sheets of Ebinewashi (traditional Japanese paper locally produced in Koriyama's Ebine-area). These were strapped on to lanterns, and lined up on the station for everyone to read. It was a beautiful, serene event that lent itself well for contemplation and remembrance.

Fukushima Ose Winery presents: Vin de Ollage

The Fukushima Ose Winery was started in 2015 in cooperation with Koriyama City and the Mitsubishi Corp. Disaster Relief Foundation in an effort to revitalize the region through new, high-quality local products. As it takes a few years to actually start producing wine, up until now, the winery only produced and sold ciders and rosé. However, on the **10th of March** this year, the winery celebrated the sale of its very first batch of wine: **Vin de Ollage**. The word 'Ollage' is derived from the term for 'our home' in the local dialect: 'Ora-ge (おら家).'

Koriyama City Marathon

Golden Week in Koriyama hasn't really started until the first opening shot is fired for the Koriyama City Marathon. Traditionally held on *Showa Day* (**April 29**th), it has become a staple event since it was first held in 1994. The event is organized by the Koriyama City Marathon Organizing Committee led by Koriyama City Hall, and supported by various local sponsors. Every year, the marathon starts at the Kaiseizan Athletics Stadium and leads the runners west towards the Ouse-area. The respective courses are 1.5k, 3k, 5k, 10k and the half-marathon, divided up into various categories for age, people with disabilities and even for parents together with their children. Famous runners this year are **Natsumi Ozawa** and **Takeshi Uchiyama**.
