A true staple of the Koriyama new year: the **Shinshu** (New Sake) **Matsuri** (Festival), or **Winter Festa in Koriyama**. Held at the Koriyama View Hotel Annex (4F) on Thursday the 7th of February, the event is considered the official opening of the new sake-season, with the first batches of new *nihon-shu* (Japanese sake) being opened. For ¥4500 (only ¥4000 in presale), enjoy and compare the taste of the new nihon-shu from 6 breweries in Koriyama, as well as various other local specialty products, such as a new special cocktail, various dishes with local brand vegetables, dishes prepared by the excellent cooking club of the Koriyama Women's University and live cooking demonstrations. Many of the products and dishes served will also be available for sale.

The new interchange is located on the crossing of Shin-Sakura Dori Street and the Tohoku Expressway, between the existing Koriyama IC and Koriyama-Minami IC, making access to the city center from the expressway much more convenient. Note: As the IC is a smart-IC without personnel, use of the IC is restricted to cars with an ETCcard. Be sure to have a working ETC-card installed in your car.

Along with the robotsumo competition, Big Palette was also the venue for the 'Robot Festival Fukushima', making for a high-tech and exciting day, and glimpse of the future.



Do you know Koriyama?

'Gozen-Ninjin' local brand carrots

Koriyama has a rich agriculture, with a great variety of excellent, delicious local products. One long-time local favorite is the 'Gozen-Ninjin'. Ninjin is the word for carrot. Gozen comes from the legendary beauty Shizuka Gozen, or Lady Shizuka, featured in the epic The Tale of Heike. An exceptional beauty, she is said to have passed away in the area that is now Koriyama City. There is a shrine in the Otsuki-area dedicated to her, as well as Shizuka-Gozen Street, one of Koriyama's major streets traversing the city from east to west. A type of local carrots was named after her because of their beautiful, long and slender shape, vivid color and exceptional sweetness. These carrots have become one the most representative of Koriyama's local products, often used in

Fukushima's most famous local dish 'ikaninjin'. Gozen-Ninjin are available at various local supermarkets, farmers-markets and local product shops. They are in season from early-November until late February.
