### The Hungarian Swimming Team's Camp in Koriyama

A group of young professional swimmers and perhaps even future Olympic medalists from the Hungarian Swimming Association's national team stayed in Koriyama between the **15<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of October** for a training camp. They trained at the newly built Koriyama Kaiseizan Shinkin Pool and the Horaiya Sogo Gymnasium. The team consisted of 12 young athletes, including Tamás Kenderesi, bronze medalist on the 100m butterfly at the 2016 Rio Olympics. On the first day of training, they were welcomed at the pool by kids of the Hozan Elementary School, who had the privilege to see the team's first training session for themselves. They also talked to the local press and gave out signatures to local school children during their stay. Koriyama hopes to welcome the

team again in the near future, and wishes them a lot of success for the 2019 World Aquatics Championship in South-Korea and at the Olympic Games in 2020!

#### Utsukushima YOSAKOI Festival 2018

Yurakkusu (YRACS) Atami in Bandai-Atami was the stage for the 18<sup>th</sup> 'Utsukushima YOSAKOI Festival' on the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of September. *Yosakoi* is a contemporary dance that originates from Kochi City in Shikoku, Japan. It is highly dynamic and combined with cheering elements, meant to energize the crowd. The festival featured 19 teams from in- and outside of Fukushima Prefecture, who all gave their all to treat the

audience to energetic, fun and beautiful performances. Winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> prize was Yosakoi team Gojin from Aizu. The event is held annually, so be sure to visit next year!
