COVID-19 Vaccination Program (Update)

The COVID-19 vaccination program in Koriyama is in full progress. All residents of Koriyama City have been sent vaccination coupons by mail.

The envelope includes the vaccine coupon, with a coupon number. Use this number to make your reservation.



Also, a Pre-Vaccination Questionnaire is included. Please fill it in before going to the vaccination clinic. A translation of the questionnaire can be found on the website below, but



please **be sure to** fill in the original Japanese questionnaire.

Once you have received your coupon, you can make a reservation at either a Collective Vaccination Venue, or your local clinic. For details, Koriyama City offers a website with information on the roll-out of the vaccine in English and Easy Japanese. The page includes information on making reservations, consultation services, your nearest clinics offering the vaccine, etc.
